

Directions to Add Keyboard (TlchqWM)

- **Click:** [Mac Download link](#)
- **Move/Drag** Zip file to Desktop
- **Unzip** the keyboard layout by either simply double clicking the zipped file.
- The icon will look like a white lego piece.
- In the Finder, choose **Go** from the menu at the top of your screen. With that drop-down menu open, hold down the **Option key**. This will make the **Library** show up in the list. Click **Library**.
- In the new Finder window, scroll down to find **Keyboard layouts**.
- Drag the keyboard layout you saved earlier into the **Keyboard layouts** list.
- Log off the computer or restart it.
- Open **System Preferences > Language and Region**. Click the **Keyboard Preferences** button at the bottom.
- Click the **Input Sources** tab at the top.
- Click the **+** (plus) sign at the bottom left to 'add a keyboard layout'.
- Select **Others** in the left-side pane, this should display a list of keyboard layouts which includes the one you are looking to activate. Select the keyboard you want and click **add**. Don't worry if the message says 'Keyboard layout not available', just ignore this.
- The layout is now ready to use.
- To access the key layout, click on the flag at the top of your screen. Select the keyboard layout from the list.
